In response to your recent request regarding the "FDA" status of Inteplast's BOPP film products we wish to offer the following information. All BOPP products have been formulated to achieve the desired end product physical properties and to be used for its intended purpose.

Inteplast Group guarantees that our BOPP products which are hereafter shipped or delivered to, or on the order of the above listed purchaser, as of the date of such shipment of delivery and subject to the conditions of use or other restrictions if any, are not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as amended.

Inteplast BOPP Films (*excluding PW and YCL) comply with the following Food and Drug Administration Regulations:

21 CFR **177.1520**: This regulation describes polypropylene and olefin copolymers that can be safely used in articles used for packaging or holding food at low temperatures and/or room temperatures.

21 CFR **178.2010**: This regulation lists antioxidants and/or stabilizers for polymers which may be safely used for the manufacture of articles which come into direct contact with food.

21 CFR **178.3130**: This regulation lists antistatic and/or antifogging agents which may be safely used for the manufacture of articles which come into direct contact with food.
